**New Business:**

By-Law Election Results – 57 members voted. 16 no, 41 yes. By-law regarding guest visits will officially change from the current 6 guest visit rule to allowing guests a total of 8 visits. Open Art visits DO count as guest visits. Workshops are considered “special events” because we bring in outside artists. Workshops will not count as guest visits.
