### **Art Show Update**

There were two radio spots done on KSCW Radio last week. There will be about 175 for the artist reception on Friday night. We have 276 paintings to hang for the show. The Rec Ctr gave us a new banner to hang at Palm Ridge. The signs have been put out on the streets in SCW. We will be putting up signs in the golf courses and Rec Centers. There have been numerous posts in social media such as Facebook. There is an article in the Independent this week. Linda Light has been working on food for the reception.

### **Education**

The hearing devices have been numbered. One transmitter is not displaying properly. The company has been called and a replacement will be sent. There needs to be a sign on the case to not move it so that the case doesn't become unplugged. Sue will put a picture on Facebook and in the newsletter of the head phone type needed for the receivers.

There will be a form at the monitor station to check-in/check-out the devices. No devices should leave the classroom, including the restroom.
